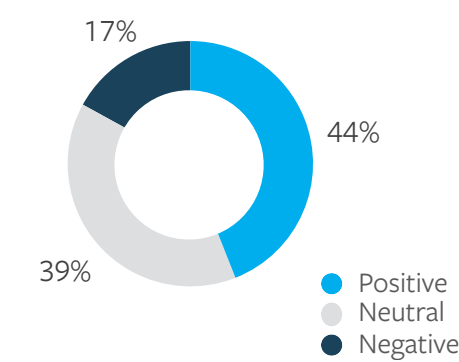


Future of Business Survey - Global

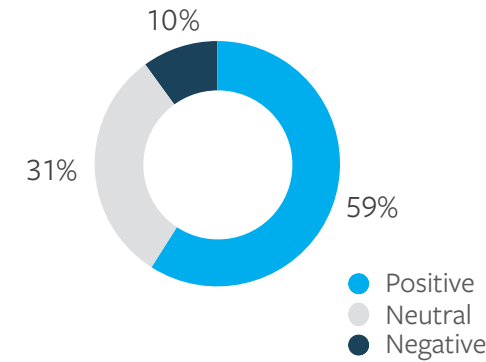

Current state of own business



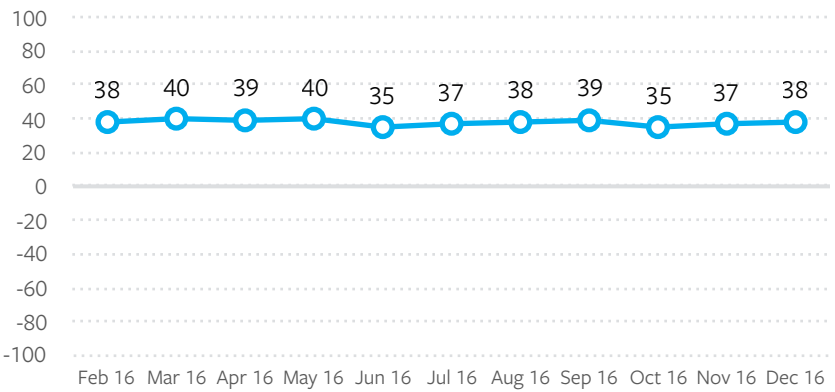
How would you evaluate the current state of your business?

Future outlook of own business



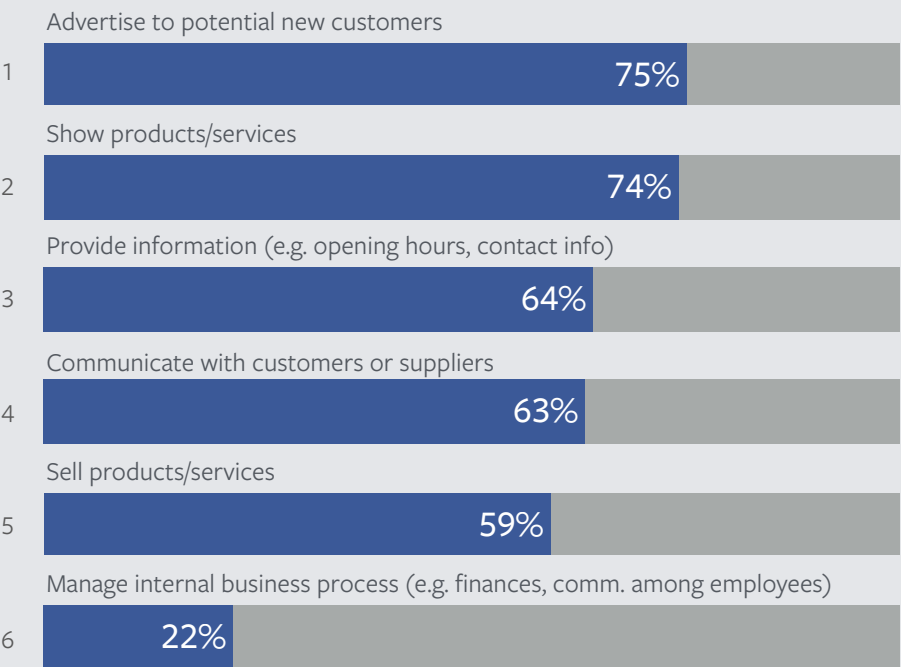
What is your outlook for the next 6 months on your business?

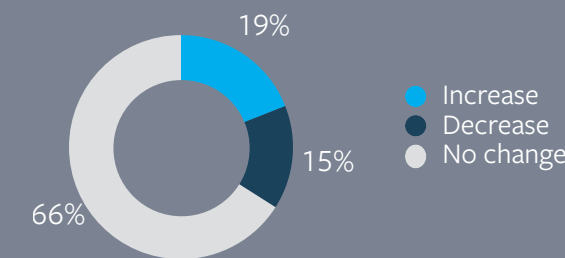

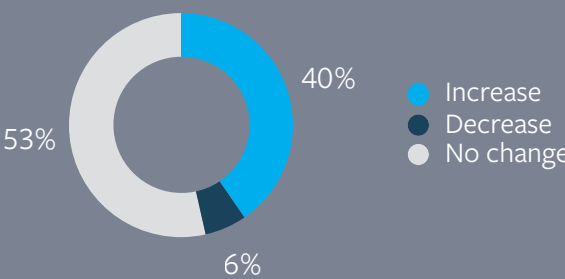
Job growth past 6 months

How did the number of employees in your business change in the last 6 months?

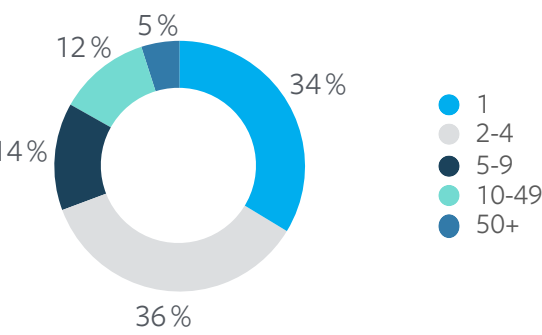


Job growth next 6 months

And how do you expect the number of employees in your business to change in the next 6 months?

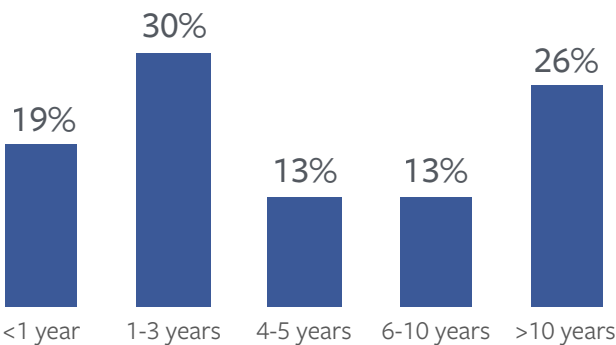

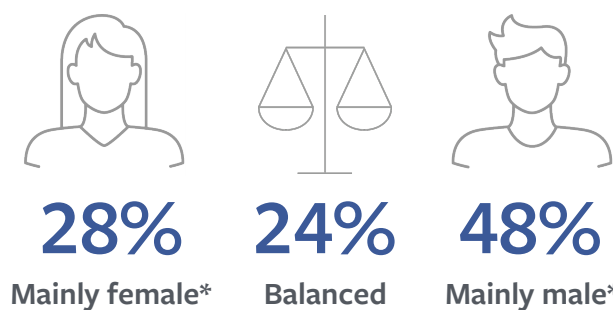
How many employees are there in your business?

Top 5 challenges



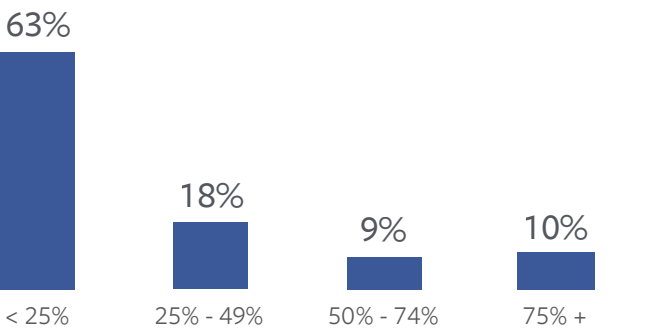
What are the most important challenges your business currently faces?

International trade*



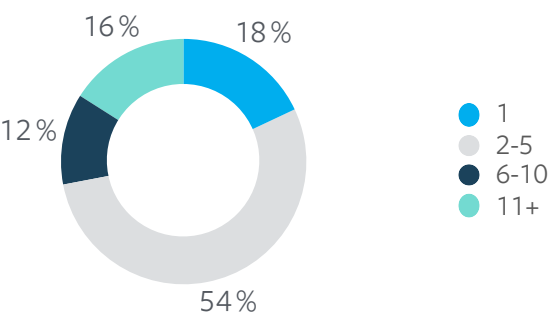
Is your company engaged in international trade?

Exports revenue



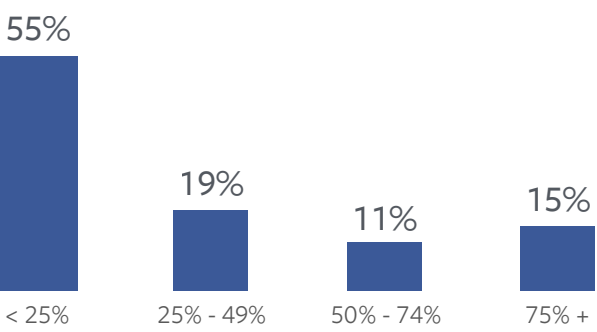
What proportion of your revenue comes from international exports?
